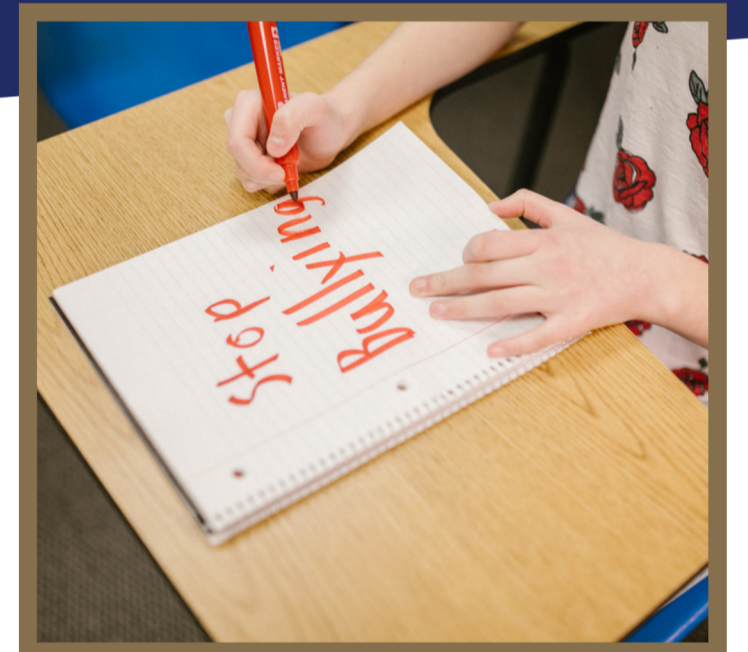

Discussion of how alternate learning styles, multicultural group formation and gender related issues can impact long term learning will be included. Teachers should become confident in addressing the issue in their classrooms and when dealing with parents and other concerned parties i.e.: administrators, guidance, and law enforcement personnel.
